



To take advantage of this amazing new feature your AirPlay equipped Denon component needs to be connected to your home network, this because all AirPlay communications are transmitted via your home network router to your AirPlay equipped Denon. Apple AirPlay is an IT technology that Denon have embraced and adapted so you can now have the best of both the IT and High Fidelity worlds working together seamlessly.

There are 4 mains applications for AirPlay and you can use just one or all.

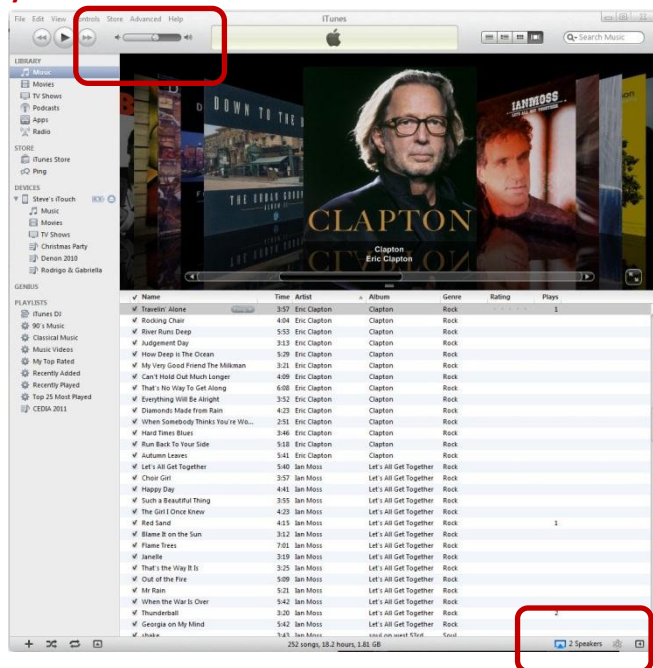
- **Streaming audio files from your iTunes Library from any PC or MAC** that is connected to the same home network that your AirPlay equipped Denon is connected to.
- **Streaming audio files from your iPhone/iPad or iTouch** wirelessly via your Wi-Fi connection to the same home network that your AirPlay equipped Denon is connected to.
- **Use the Apple Remote APP** on your iPhone/iPad or iTouch to control and operate your iTunes Library on your PC or MAC
- **Use the Denon Remote APP** on your iPhone/iPad or iTouch to control and operate your Denon component. *(This is not strictly part of AirPlay as the Denon Remote APP can be used on non AirPlay equipped products but they must be connected to your home network)*

Application Number 1

Streaming audio files from your iTunes Library from any PC or MAC.

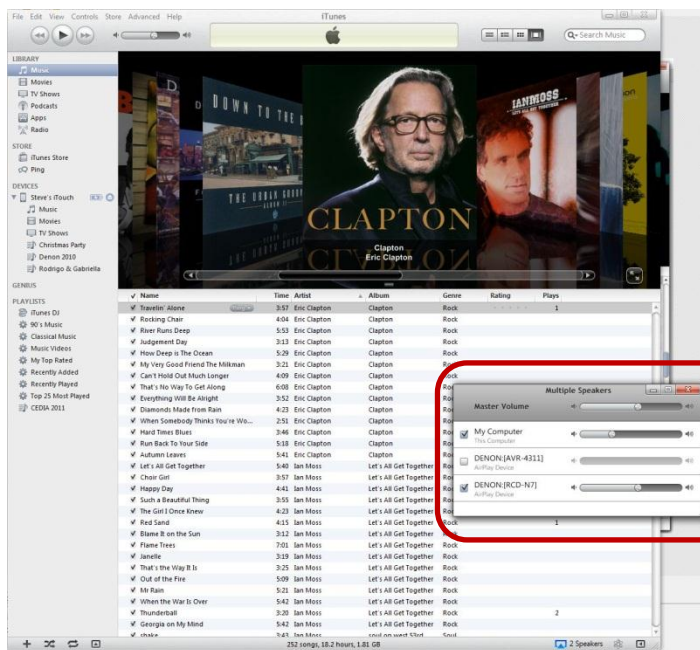
- Connect your AirPlay equipped Denon component to your home network.
- This is achieved by connecting an Ethernet cable (or Wi-Fi where applicable) to your AirPlay equipped Denon and to your home network router or network switch.
- The default setting on your Denon is DHCP on so an IP address will be automatically allocated to Ethernet only units.
- If your Denon has a Wi-Fi option you will need to follow the instructions on network connection from your instruction manual and setup according to your choice of Wi-Fi or Ethernet connections.
- Once connected to your home network make sure you have turned on the “Network Standby” function on your AirPlay equipped Denon component. This will mean your AirPlay equipped Denon will use slightly more power when in standby mode but when this feature is turned on and enabled it means that when you select the AirPlay feature from your iTunes library on your PC or MAC it will automatically turn on your AirPlay equipped Denon from standby mode and start playing your iTunes library selection, it even allows you to control the volume of your AirPlay equipped Denon from your iTunes library.

AirPlay switch in iTunes

- If you have more than one AirPlay equipped device connected when you select the AirPlay switch in iTunes the Multiple Speaker selection box will appear
- You can select which AirPlay equipped device you wish to stream to, you can choose all or just one unit
- You also have the option of individual volume controls for each AirPlay equipped device connected (see below)

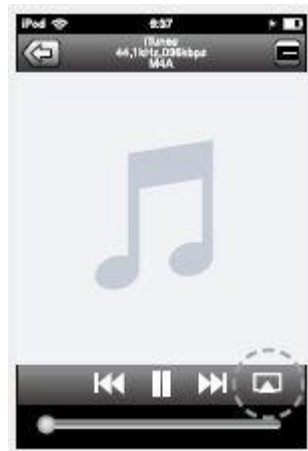


AirPlay Multiple Speaker selection box with Volume controls

Application Number 2

Streaming audio files from your iPhone, iPad or iPod

- Make sure your iPhone, iPad or iPod Wi-Fi is enabled and set to the same home network as your AirPlay equipped Denon is connected to.
 - This can be setup in the “Settings” section of your iPhone, iPad or iPod
- Select music on your iPhone, iPad or iPod and you will see the AirPlay icon at the bottom of your screen (see below)



- When you select the AirPlay icon you can choose which device you wish to stream your music to. (see below)



- If you have your AirPlay equipped Denon's "Network Standby" feature enabled you can even remotely turn your Denon on from standby mode by using this feature and use the portable devices volume control to adjust the volume on your Denon.

Application Number 3

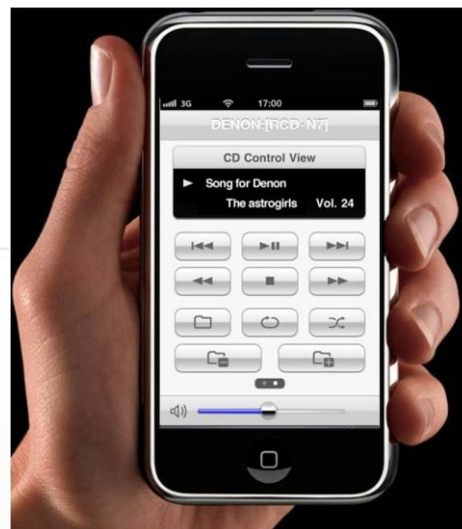
- Use the Apple Remote APP on your iPhone/iPad or iTouch to control and operate your iTunes Library on your PC or MAC



- This Apple Remote APP can be downloaded for free and it allows you to control your iTunes library on your PC or MAC with your portable device.
- You can use all AirPlay features of iTunes with this Remote APP

Application Number 4

- Use the Denon Remote APP on your iPhone/iPad or iTouch to control and operate your Denon component



- This Denon Remote APP can be downloaded for free and it allows you to control and operate your Denon with your portable device.
- This will even show album artwork on streaming content
